Program Hub Frequently Asked Questions NCAA Division II 50th Anniversary Scholarship

1. I entered my student-athlete's first/last name and email address under the nominator tab, why haven't my student-athletes received an email from Program Hub?

Although the student-athlete's name and email address are required for the first step in the nomination process, Program Hub will **NOT** send the application to their email address. It is the responsibility of the athletics administrator to complete the application in Program Hub on behalf of both student-athletes. We recommend sending the application as a PDF to the student-athletes ahead of time so they can provide you (the administrator) the necessary information to complete their application.

2. I am trying to nominate someone, why don't I see the nominator tab?

Only administrators with the following titles have access to nominate in Program Hub for the 50th anniversary scholarship: President, Chancellor, Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator, Senior Compliance Administrator, Athletics Diversity and Inclusion Designee, Faculty Athletics Representative, Head Athletic Trainer, Student-Athlete Affairs Administrator, Student-Athlete Advisor, and Sports Information Director.

3. I am trying to complete an application and it doesn't appear under my applications tab.

Only administrators with the following titles have access to complete an application on behalf of their student-athletes in Program Hub for the 50th anniversary scholarship: President, Chancellor, Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator, Senior Compliance Administrator, Athletics Diversity and Inclusion Designee, Faculty Athletics Representative, Head Athletic Trainer, Student-Athlete Affairs Administrator, Student-Athlete Advisor, and Sports Information Director.

4. For a student-athlete to be eligible for the 50th anniversary scholarship, they must have athletics eligibility remaining through the 2024-25 academic year. Can a student-athlete with eligibility exhausting in the fall of 2024 or the winter of 2025 still be nominated?

Yes, absolutely! As long as the student-athlete remains in Division II and has athletics eligibility remaining during the fall, winter or spring seasons of the 2024-25 academic year, the student-athlete is eligible for this scholarship opportunity.

5. When will the scholarship funds be distributed?

Scholarship funds will be distributed for use during the fall semester of the 2024-25 academic year.
