
### NCAA Division II 50th Anniversary Scholarship Program Hub Support



#### **STEP 1:**

Log into Program Hub with approved administrator credentials\*


Go to the "Nominator" tab on the top right-hand side of the screen.

Click "Nominate" on the left-hand side of the NCAA Division II 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Scholarship program.

\*Administrators approved for nominating access: President, Chancellor, Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator, Senior Compliance Administrator, Athletics Diversity and Inclusion Designee, Faculty Athletics Representative, Head Athletic Trainer, Student-Athlete Affairs Administrator, Student-Athlete Advisor, and Sports Information Director.

Click "Add Person"





#### STEP 3:

Add the **student-athlete's** email, first/last name. Please note this should be the STUDENT-ATHLETE'S information, **not the nominator**.

Click "Save and Continue"

NOTE: This does NOT send a copy of the application to the studentathlete's email, you will need to ask them to provide you the required information to complete the application on their behalf!





#### STEP 4:

# LEAVE THE NOMINATOR TAB IN PROGRAM HUB

Click the "Applications" tab on the upper left-hand side of the screen.

Click "Update Registration Application for (Insert Student-Athlete's Name here)"




### **STEP 5:**

Complete the 14-question nomination application on behalf of both your male and female nominated student-athletes.

We recommend providing a PDF copy of the application to each student-athlete ahead of time so they can prepare the information for you.

Again, you as the administrator are required to submit this information on their behalf!
