



OPPORTUNITY

Preliminary Rounds

- Men's basketball has aligned with the other NCAA championships.
- This bid cycle will award sites for 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026.
- Bids in each year will be awarded for:
 - 1 First Four site.
 - 8 first/second round sites.
 - 4 regional sites.

BID PROCESS

Bid Requirements

- Championship venues and diagrams (seating/back-of-house).
- Proposed budgets/financial stewardship.
- Enhancements/exceptions, if any.
- Ticket pricing worksheet.
- Hotel contracts.
- Key contact form.
- Safety and security plans.
- Community engagement initiative recommendations.

Competition Venue

- Minimum 10,000-seat capacity.
- Venue can be on or off campus.
- 150-seat capacity media workroom.
- 75-seat capacity media interview room.
- Other back-of-house requirements.
- New construction must be completed at least one year prior to hosting.

Hotels

- Full-service hotels preferred.
 - Team/media hotel. (5 9)
 - Game officials' hotel. (1)
- Competitive rates.
- Proximity to venue and airport.
- No planned renovations.
- 15 hotels closest to the competition venue. (full service and select-service)

Additional Host Considerations

- Review availability of the venue and dates in bid specifications (NCAA set-up two days before the first games).
- Confirm venue room/space needs and that all meet the standards outlined in bid specifications.
- Consider additional hotel meeting space and room inventory in your city (are there hotel needs for other events in the city at the same time).
- Ensure adequate staffing and volunteer base.

NCAA Considerations

- Airline service and equipment (quality jet service and frequency of arrivals).
- Hosts are from the NCAA Division I membership (membership co-hosts are acceptable).
- Attendance and financial history.
- Honorarium capped at \$200,000/\$300,000.
- Geographic requirements.

TIMELINE

August 26 Bid portal opened.

• February 3, 2020 Bid declarations due. (5 p.m. ET)

February - May Bid review.

• July – October Committee deliberations.

October 23, 2020 Host sites announced.
