


- Flexibility



# NCAA HOUSING

- Responsibilities of Host Sites
  - Verify housing market is sufficient to meet room block requirements
  - Recommend properties for consideration
  - Disclose special relationships/arrangements
  - **Do not secure/contract lodging or discuss rates**


- Review lodging section of bid responses
- Connect with host to discuss options proposed
- Perform additional research and validation on lodging in bid cities, as necessary

# LODGING



- **Develop championship specific RFPs, requesting blocks for participating teams, NCAA staff, committee members, media, game officials, and guests (if applicable)**
- **Research markets**
- **Distribute RFPs**
- **Receive, review and analyze RFP submissions**
- **Negotiate with properties, as needed**

# LODGING

- Anthony Travel presents lodging options to NCAA
- NCAA makes final decision on lodging selections
- Anthony Travel to draft and negotiate contracts based on standard contract template
- NCAA to sign contracts
- **NOTE: Bids contingent on successful hotel contracting**

- Obtain actuals from hotels by day during the event and a final summary of all rooms actualized within three days of group departure
- Survey teams and guests for feedback on properties
- Manage billing and collections
- Assist in invoice reconciliation and payment as appropriate
- Collect and consolidate housing data
- Provide operational and strategic reporting
