Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 20,000 (at least 15 percent of capacity should be premium seating, this may include suite seating).
- Minimum of four spacious locker rooms and locker room space for a minimum of eight game officials.
- Press box media space for 200.
- One windowless 10' x 10' or larger soundproof room for game presentation video shots.

Financial Terms

- Currently it does not have a guarantee.
- Preferred considerations shall be given to hosts, competition venue and surrounding area/facilities that agree to provide a guarantee or other enhanced revenue model.
- At minimum, after gross receipts are determined, the host/LOC receiving the budgeted expenses or actual expense, whichever is less.
- Once those obligations have been met, if there are any remaining funds, the NCAA and the host/LOC will split those 80% for the NCAA and 20% for the host/LOC.





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Lodging Requirements

- All hotels should be in close proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the stadium.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and be distanced from the stadium.
- A minimum of sixty double/double sleeping rooms for each DI team.
- Forty-five double/double rooms for each DII and DIII teams.
- Two complimentary bedroom suites (for the head coach and the administration) are recommended.
