



NCAA Divisions I, II, and III Women's Lacrosse Championship Executive Summary

Dates

- May 25 – 27, 2029
- May 24 – 26, 2030
- May 23 – 25, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Seating capacity should be 10,000 minimum.
- Minimum of four spacious locker rooms, with a preference of six.
- Locker room space for a minimum of eight game officials, preferably two separate locker rooms.
- A lined practice field with goals, of the same surface as the game field.
- An indoor practice field option, in case of inclement weather. The indoor option can be off-site, so long as there is no additional expense to the NCAA.

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels should be in close proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the stadium, and the team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and be distanced from the stadium.
- Division I Team Hotels: a minimum of 30 double/double, 7 Kings, and 1 suite.
- Division II Team Hotels: a minimum of 24 double/double and 1 suite.
- Division III Team Hotels: a minimum of 24 double/double and 1 king/suite.
- NCAA Headquarters Hotel: 35 rooms with a combination of doubles and kings.
