



NCAA Division I Men's Ice Hockey Championship Executive Summary

Dates

- April 5 & 7, 2029
- April 11 & 13, 2030
- April 10 & 12, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum capacity 17,000.
- Must have access to a minimum of two ice resurfacing machines during all practices and game days.
- Eight (8) viewing suites during practices and games.
- A minimum of two private meeting rooms for a minimum of 200 individuals.
- Four separate and comparable locker rooms.
 - Must accommodate a minimum of 31 individuals with a minimum of 23 hockey lockers.
- One locker room for game officials.
- Training room to accommodate 15-20.
 - Equipped with basic supplies and equipment.
- Press box media seating for 150.
 - Access and use of at least eight booths in the press box.
- Press box media seating for 150.
- Media workspace for 200.
 - At least 600 square feet.
- A media interview room set theater-style for 125 individuals.
- Five separate interview/breakout rooms.
- One windowless 10' x 10' or larger soundproof room.
- Two separate rooms for drug testing, each with a waiting area, toilet facilities to accommodate 10.
- One "green" room or space near the playing surface to accommodate 10 – 15.

Financial Terms

- \$2.7 million guarantee.
- Concession revenue share of \$2 per session per attendee.
- 20% of gross alcohol sales.





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Lodging Requirements

- Separate hotels are needed for the NCAA, media, officials, and participating teams.
 - Game officials and teams may not stay in the same hotel.
 - It may be permissible for the media or game officials to be assigned to the same property as the NCAA headquarters hotel.
- All hotels shall be in proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the venue.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from venue.
