



## NCAA Division I Men's Swimming and Diving Championship Executive Summary

### Dates

- March 21 – 24, 2029
- March 27 – 30, 2030
- March 26 – 29, 2031

### Facility Requirements

- Minimum 1,500 capacity with preference for seating to accommodate 1,800.
- Adequate locker rooms for approximately 400 participating student-athletes.
  - Gender-neutral changing rooms must be provided.
  - Locker rooms assignments are not necessary, but adequate lockers must be available.
- 25-yard course.
  - Minimum water depth of 7 feet (2.13 meters).
  - 8 lanes, 7 feet in width, with additional width outside lanes 1 and 8.
- The diving well must be at least 60 feet in length and 75 feet in width.
- Two one-meter diving springboards less than one year old.
- Two three-meter diving springboards less than one year old.
- Diving tower with takeoff platforms at 5, 7.5 and 10 meters.
- A permanent hot tub should be available for divers.
  - If a permanent hot tub is not available, a temporary tub must be provided.
- An athletic training facility with adequate modalities must be available for student-athletes within or immediately adjacent to the competition venue.
  - Ice baths to accommodate 20-25 student-athletes at one time must be available immediately adjacent to the competition deck.
- Separate meeting rooms for:
  - NCAA staff, media work area, interview area, private room for viewing relay exchange, a private area immediately off-deck for the games committee to meet, hospitality areas, drug testing.

### Lodging Requirements

- Separate hotels are needed for the NCAA, media, officials, and participating teams.
  - Game officials and teams may not stay in the same hotel.
  - Media or game officials can be assigned to the same property as the NCAA headquarters hotel.



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- All hotels shall be in proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the venue.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from venue.
