Dates

- March 15– 17, 2029
- March 21 – 23, 2030
- March 20 – 22, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum capacity 18,000 in 8-mat configuration.
- Competition floor 100 x 200.
- At least three locker rooms.
- Warm up space.
 - Area to place at least one (1) 30 x 30 mat.
- Space to accommodate team camps.
 - Sixty-five (65) 12 x 12 spaces.

Financial Terms

- \$3M Guarantee.
- Concession revenue share of \$3 per session per attendee.
- 20% of gross alcohol sales.

Lodging Requirements

- Need at least three separate hotels (Teams, HQ, Media).
- Preference for team hotels to be within 5 miles of the competition venue.
