



NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship Executive Summary

Dates

- December 14 – 16 or 17, 2028-29
- December 13 – 15 or 16, 2029-30
- December 19 – 21 or 22, 2030-31

Facility Requirements

- The facility must have at least 17,000 seats with a preference for 18,000.
- Provide four separate and comparable locker rooms for the participating teams.
- Three additional locker rooms; two for game officials and one for the floor crew
- During the season in which the facility will host the championship, it is recommended to host a minimum of one college volleyball game prior to November 1.
- The NCAA should be provided exclusive use of eight complimentary viewing suites during practices and matches.
- The host site will be responsible for providing, at no cost to the NCAA, banquet space and volunteer staff for an information function for all participating student-athletes, coaches/support staff, the NCAA staff and committee, LOC and affiliated organizations.
- The host site will be responsible for providing space at no charge and volunteer staff to support an interactive fan festival.

Financial Terms

- Minimum financial guarantee of \$500,000.
- After gross receipts are determined, the NCAA will receive the established guarantee, followed by the host/LOC receiving the budgeted expenses or actual expense, whichever is less.
- Once both obligations have been met, if there are any remaining funds, the NCAA and the host/LOC will split those 80% for the NCAA and 20% for the host/LOC.

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels should be in close proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the competition venue.
- Team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from the competition venue.
