

NCAA DI Men's and Women's Indoor Track & Field Championship Executive Summary

Dates

- March 9 10, 2029
- March 8 9, 2030
- March 14 15, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 3,500 seats (5,000 preferred).
- Tracks, runways, and take-off areas should be covered with synthetic material and shall be able to accept a minimum of 7 mm (1/4") in spike length. In high jump, the surface shall be able to accept a minimum of 9 mm (3/8") in spike length.
- The oval track must be a banked track, 200 meters in length.
- The warm-up area must provide expansive space with plenty of track surface available for student-athletes to practice block starts and hurdle drills while wearing spikes.
- Dual high jump and shot put areas for simultaneous competitions in the combined events are preferred.
- The facility should have an adequate team camp space able to accommodate up to 150 different institutions and their necessary personnel and equipment.

Lodging Requirements

• Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
