Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 2,500 seats.
- Competition floor a minimum of 200x 100' is suggested. Facility needs to be able to accommodate six full-size wrestling mats, 43'x43', mat-side tables, video equipment, and chairs for medical personnel.
- At least two locker rooms.
- Space to accommodate team camps.
- Warm-up space.
 - o Area to place at least 2 full-size wrestling mats.

• Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
