Dates

- May 16 – 20, 2028 (Practice Day: May 15)
- May 15 – 19, 2029 (Practice Day: May 14)
- May 14 – 18, 2030 (Practice Day: May 13)
- May 13 – 17, 2031 (Practice Day: May 12)

Facility Requirements

- The course should be arranged in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf as far in advance as possible.
- At least one scoreboard in a location that is easily viewable by spectators.
- Will supply electric golf carts for use by competing institutions, the NCAA committee and officials (approximately 60).

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels should be in close proximity (e.g., less than 30 minutes from the golf course).
- Team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from the golf course.
- Preference Room Types:
 - Three Double/Doubles, two Kings per team (18 teams).
 - Two Kings per individual (8 individuals) OR four Double/Doubles (18 teams).
 - Two Kings per individual (8 individuals).
 - 10 room buffer for additional institutional staff.
