Dates

- November 18, 2028
- November 17, 2029
- November 23, 2030

Facility Requirements

- Course Distance: Men – 10,000 meters; Women – 6,000 meters.
- The preferred width of the course should not be less than 10 meters throughout.
- During the season in which the facility will host the championship, the host will be required to host the pre-national meet in October. Date should be mutually agreed upon with NCAA.

Lodging Requirements

- Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of the competition venue.
