Dates

- March 9 – 10, 2029
- March 8 – 9, 2030
- March 14 – 15, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 1,500 seats.
- It is the preference of the NCAA Division II Track and Field Committee that the track be a 200-meter banked track.
- Dual high jump and shot put areas for simultaneous competitions in the combined events are preferred.
- The facility should have space available for the management of the event including a clerking area large enough to house 50 athletes, a warm-up area for athletes prior to reporting to the clerk, an athlete interview area and an area convenient for conducting a drug-testing program.

Lodging Requirements

- Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
