Dates

- May 24 – 26, 2029
- May 23 – 25, 2030
- May 22 – 24, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 2,000 seats.
- The ability to conduct two high jump, two pole vault, two long jump/triple jump and two shot put competitions at the same time is desirable.
- The facility should have space available for the management of the event including a clerking area large enough to house 50 athletes, a warm-up area in close proximity for athletes prior to reporting to the clerk, team camp space, an athlete interview area and an area convenient for conducting a drug-testing program.

Lodging Requirements

- Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
