#### **Dates**

- March 23 25, 2029

### **Facility Requirements**

- Minimum seating capacity of 1,000 seats.
- The facility must have access to two ice-resurfacing machines.
- The facility must have two benches that can accommodate a minimum of 23 studentathletes and additional coaching staff/personnel.
- The facility must be equipped with a skate sharpener on site; and provide all participating teams with contact information for a local state repair company.
- The facility must accommodate four locker rooms.
- The facility or host must provide a venue to accommodate the championship banquet for up to 200 individuals to take place on the Thursday prior to competition.

#### **Lodging Requirements**

• Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
