Dates

- March 23 – 25, 2029
- March 22 – 24, 2030
- March 21 – 23, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 1,000 seats.
- The facility must have access to two ice-resurfacing machines.
- The facility must have two benches that can accommodate a minimum of 23 student-athletes and additional coaching staff/personnel.
- The facility must be equipped with a skate sharpener on site; and provide all participating teams with contact information for a local state repair company.
- The facility must accommodate four locker rooms.
- The facility or host must provide a venue to accommodate the championship banquet for up to 200 individuals to take place on the Thursday prior to competition.

Lodging Requirements

- Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
