Dates

- March 15 & 17, 2029
- March 14 & 16, 2030
- March 20 & 22, 2031

Facility Requirements

- The facility must have a minimum of four separate team locker rooms of comparable size.
- Host facility must be equipped with the following: electric scoreboard, video board and/or LED scorer's table (one or the other required, having both is preferred), public address system, mounted shot clock and athletic training facilities.
- The facility should seat a minimum of 1100 spectators, preferably 1500 or more.
- Willing to host a collegiate all-star game prior to the championship game.

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels should be in close proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the competition venue.
- Room types per team: 15 Doubles, 2 Kings (prefer one to be a king suite).
