Dates

- November 17 and 19, 2028
- November 16 and 18, 2029
- November 22 and 24, 2030

Facility Requirements

- Minimum 750 capacity.
- 100 x 60 game field.
 - Spectators must be at least 10 yards from the field and may not sit or stand behind the goals.
- Spacious locker room with a whiteboard for each team for practice and games
- An athletic training area adequately staffed and large enough to accommodate the participating teams.
 - Arrange for planned access to a physician, preferably a team physician.
- Minimum of six team locker rooms.
- Locker room space for a minimum of five umpires.
- One meeting room to accommodate 30 individuals.
- The media postgame interview room large enough to accommodate 20 people
- Banquet facility for 175 people.

Lodging Requirements

- Separate hotels are needed for the NCAA, officials, and participating teams.
 - Game officials and teams may not stay in the same hotel.
 - Game officials can be assigned to the same property as the NCAA headquarters hotel.
- All hotels shall be in close proximity from the venue.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from venue.
