Dates

- March 23 & 25, 2029
- March 22 & 24, 2030
- March 28 & 30, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum capacity 1,000.
- The facility must have two benches that can accommodate a minimum of 23 student-athletes and additional coaching staff/personnel.
- The facility must have access to an ice-resurfacing machine during all practice and game days. It is strongly recommended that a host has access to a second ice-resurfacing machine.
- The facility must be equipped with a skate sharpener, and the host must provide each team with contact information for a local skate repair store.
- The facility must have four clean and equipped team locker rooms.
- The facility must have a clean and equipped officials locker room (two if mixed gender crew).

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels shall be in close proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the event venue.
- All hotels must have a private space for teams to watch film or have meetings.
