Facility Requirements

- The oval track shall be 200 meters in length and may not exceed 300 meters.
- It is preferred the facility have two runways for pole vault, long jump, and triple jump.
- Dual high jump areas for simultaneous competitions in the combined events are preferred.
- The facility should have space available for the management of the event including a clerk area large enough to accommodate 50 athletes, a warm-up area for athletes prior to reporting to the clerk, an athlete interview area, and an area convenient for conducting a drug-testing program.

Lodging Requirements

• Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
