- May 24 26, 2029

Facility Requirements

- Minimum seating capacity of 3,000 seats (preferred 4,000).
- Two runways for pole vault, long jump, and triple jump are preferred.
- Dual high jump areas for simultaneous competitions in the combined events are preferred.
- The facility should have space available for the management of the event, including a clerking area large enough to accommodate 75 student-athletes.

Lodging Requirements

• Preference for team hotels to be within close proximity of competition venue.
