Dates

- April 19 – 21, 2029
- April 18 – 20, 2030
- April 17 – 19, 2031

Facility Requirements

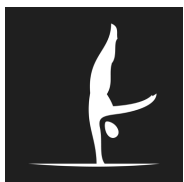
- Venue size varies but must be able to accommodate set-up with a podium.
 - Smallest recent square footage was 11,040 square feet.
- Minimum capacity 5,000.
- Minimum two separate locker rooms (three to six is preferable).
 - Each locker room should accommodate up to three teams.
- Separate meeting spaces for athletics training, drug testing, media, judges, and coaches.
- The facility must be available from noon on Sunday proceeding the competition.

Lodging Requirements

- Separate hotels are needed for the NCAA, officials, and participating teams.
 - Game officials and teams may not stay in the same hotel.
 - Game officials to be assigned to the same property as the NCAA headquarters hotel.
- All hotels shall be in proximity from the venue.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from the venue.
