



NCAA National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Executive Summary

Dates

- May 12 and 14, 2029
- May 11 and 13, 2030
- May 10 and 12, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Must have at least 3,500 seats.
- The facility must have a free playing space measuring a minimum of 7 meters (approximately 23 feet) in height from the playing surface. It is preferred to have a free playing surface measuring 12.5 meters (approximately 41 feet).
- The facility needs four separate and comparable locker rooms for the participating teams and two additional for the game officials.
- Warm-up facility/space located within a reasonable distance to the competition floor.
- During the season in which the facility will host the championship, it must host a minimum of one college volleyball match prior to April 1.

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels should be in close proximity from the event venue, and the team hotels must be of comparable quality and distance from the playing venue.
- A minimum of thirteen double/double and three king sleeping rooms for each team is required.
- NCAA and officials can stay at the same property.
