Dates

- April 19 – 21, 2029
- April 18 – 20, 2030
- April 17 – 19, 2031

Facility Requirements

- Minimum venue size 26,500 square feet.
 - 125' W x 215' L
- Minimum capacity 8,000.
- Minimum eight separate locker rooms.
- Athletic training area(s) to accommodate 70 student-athletes per session.

Lodging Requirements

- Separate hotels are needed for the NCAA, media, officials, and participating teams
 - Game officials and teams may not stay in the same hotel.
 - It may be permissible for the media or game officials to be assigned to the same property as the NCAA headquarters hotel.
- All hotels shall be in proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the venue.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from venue.
