

NCAA National Collegiate Women's Water Polo Championship Executive Summary

Dates

- April 25*, 27 29, 2029
- April 24*, 26 28, 2030
- April 23*, 25 27, 2031

*The championship provides for a field of eight teams; however, there is currently one opening round game (with the possibility of two) prior to the championship. The host venue shall be available to host the opening round game(s) the Wednesday prior to the championship, as well as the finals.

Facility Requirements

- The minimum depth of the water shall be 2 meters (6.5 feet) or 2.13 meters (7 feet) in facilities that were built after January 1, 1990.
- Team benches must be on the side opposite the scorer's table, unless permanent structural facility restrictions prevent such location.
- Minimum of two team locker rooms are required (four is preferred) to accommodate at least 16 student-athletes.
- Two locker rooms ideally for the game officials to accommodate four individuals.
 - o If all officials are the same gender, then one locker room will suffice.
- Separate meeting spaces for athletic training, media (space for 20), interviews (space for 20), and two separate rooms for drug testing.
- A warm-up pool in close proximity to the competition venue is preferred.
- The facility must be available for practices on Tuesday the week of the championship.

Lodging Requirements

- Separate hotels are needed for the NCAA, officials, and participating teams.
 - o Game officials and teams may not stay in the same hotel.
 - It may be permissible for game officials to be assigned to the same property as the NCAA headquarters hotel.
- All hotels shall be in proximity (ideally within walking distance) from the venue.
- The team hotel(s) must be of comparable quality and distance from venue.
- The hotel should provide complimentary meeting space for teams.
