



NCAA National Collegiate Men's and Women's Rifle Championship Executive Summary

Dates

- March 9 – 10, 2029
- March 8 – 9, 2030
- March 14 – 15, 2031

Facility Requirements

- The facility must have the capability of accommodating the NCAA portable range or a similar set up.
 - The NCAA portable range is a 26-foot range with a 10-meter and 50-foot firing line.
 - Additional space (30-foot minimum) behind the 50-foot line, for competitors and range officer is required.
 - Approximate minimum size for the total range is 100 feet wide and 80 feet long.
 - Basketball arenas, indoor tracks and field houses have been successful past venues.
- Electronic targets for Air Rifle (10 meter) and Smallbore (50 feet).
- Balances or scales for weighting rifles in kilograms.
- A minimum of four compressed air tanks (scuba size) – a minimum of two fresh compressed air tanks for the air match rifle match day.
- There shall be a banquet facility available for the championship banquet to accommodate approximately 130 people.

Lodging Requirements

- All hotels shall be in close proximity (within 30 miles or 30 minutes) from the venue.
