KEY ELEMENTS

- Teams typically arrive two days prior to the championship.
- There is one day of practice with media availability/press conferences the day before competition.
- The entire tournament is between 14 and 17 games, Friday Thursday (Practice Thursday upon arrival).

BID CONSIDERATIONS

Facility

- Spectator capacity at least 3,000 permanent. Natural surface preferred.)
- Two comparable dugouts.
- Access to indoor practice facility (inclement weather).
- 2 team locker rooms and umpire (8) locker rooms and training rooms.
- Ancillary space- press box media space to accommodate a min. of 20 working media and media press conference area. (see bid specs for full list of requirements).

Lodging

- Team: Multiple team hotels with meeting space. Teams can stay in same hotel or share (Equal experience). 14 doubles, 2 kings .
- Headquarter: 30 kings; hotel can be separate property or included with team hotel blocks.
- Officials: 12 kings; cannot be include in team hotel block.
- Proximity to competition venue and interstates/airports.
