DIVISION II FIELD HOCKEY

- FACILITY: Typically hosted on campus of a Division II institution
 - Artificial or Astro surface is preferred, committee reviews both types of surfaces for bids
 - Prefer four separate team locker rooms of equal space and quality
 - Officials locker room required, two preferred (for mixed gender crews)
 - Must have an extensive evacuation plan
 - Seating for a minimum of 500 people

• SCHEDULE:

- o Championship is held the Friday and Sunday prior to Thanksgiving.
- It occurs on the same weekend as Division I and Division III
- Semifinals occur at noon and 3, with championship game at noon
- Practice days are Thursday and Saturday



DIVISION II FIELD HOCKEY

ANCILLARY:

- Student-athlete banquet the evening of the first practice day. A banquet space on or off-campus for about 150 people
- Division II will organize a community service opportunity for teams

LODGING:

- 2-4 team hotels preferred. One for NCAA staff, committee and officials.
- 20 room nights PER team. 15 room nights for HQ/officials.
- Team lodging with meeting space is imperative
- ATTENDANCE: On average, we see 700+ fans throughout the weekend
- Invested, committed hosts are the key to success.
