    - Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, or
    - Thursday, Friday, Sunday
  - All rounds broadcast on ESPN+




- 2029, 2030, and 2031 Championships
- Finals
  - 2 days of competition, with 1 day of rest
    - Thursday (two sessions) and Saturday
  - Top 8 teams and individual competitors in the country, including Olympians
  - 23,000+ attendance in 2025

  - Broadcast on ESPN and ABC




