KEY ELEMENTS

- The Men's & Women's Fencing Championships consists of a separate championship for each gender, with a team and individual component for both.
- Each gender competes on separate days.
 - In even years, the women compete Thursday/Friday, and the men compete Saturday/Sunday
 - In odd years, the men compete Thursday/Friday, and the women compete Saturday/Sunday

FENCING FACILITY NEEDS

- A minimum spectator seating capacity of 1,000
- The facility must be able to accommodate a minimum of nine competition strips and six practice strips.
 - Each competition strip require a space of 70 feet long by 36 feet wide which is enclosed by a three-for-tall pipe and drape.
- A separate location (within the same venue, or within reasonable distance from it) must be provided for a raised strip set-up, used for the semi-finals and finals of each individual weapon.
- Basketball arenas, indoor tracks and field houses have been successful past venues.

FENCING FACILITY NEEDS CONTINUED

- Ancillary space for team camp, to house 144 individuals.
- Three hospitality spaces, one each for staff, coaches, and studentathletes.
- Projection screens, monitors and/or video boards available at the competition venue to display live match scores and results. Screens large enough for spectator viewing of scores is required. If possible, scores viewable by the competitors is desirable. Projectors, laptops and other necessary equipment to provide scoring displays must be provided.
