



2026-27 Provisional and Reclassifying Institutions Selection Criteria Policies

Institutions Entering Division II.

Institutions in the Division II membership process (provisional or reclassifying) will be considered Division II institutions in all required and additional sport-specific selection criteria (as approved by the national sport committee).

NOTE: To be eligible for NCAA Division II championships, an institution must be an active member in good standing per NCAA Division II Bylaw 18.2.2 [effective August 1, 2023].

Institutions Leaving Division II.

Once a Division II institution enters the process to reclassify to Division I or Division III, it is treated as a member of the division to which it is reclassifying (e.g., Division I or Division III). Contests against these institutions will not count in the selection criteria for active Division II member institutions. Division II institutions that are reclassifying to Division I or Division III are no longer eligible for Division II championships once they enter the reclassifying process.
