

PLAYING RULES CHANGES RELATED TO COMMEMORATIVE/ MEMORIAL UNIFORM PATCHES SUPPORTING RACIAL AND SOCIAL JUSTICE JULY 29, 2020

In an effort to allow student-athletes the opportunity to use the uniform to voice their opinions and/or express support of racial and social justice, PROP reviewed the current uniform rules across all sports. Although the rules currently vary from sport-to-sport, PROP voted to direct all playing rules committees to implement the following policies for all sports effective with the 2020-21 seasons:

- As authorized by the institution or conference, allow a commemorative/memorial patch (e.g., names, mascots, nicknames, logos, and marks intended to celebrate or memorialize persons, events, or other causes).
- The patch must not exceed 4 square inches and must be placed on the front or sleeve of the uniform and may not interfere with any required markings.
- While not all team members are required to wear the patch, the patch must be identical for those who choose to wear the patch.
- As authorized by the institution or conference, allow other names/words intended to celebrate or memorialize persons, events, or other causes on the back of the jersey/uniform where the player name is traditionally located. The names/words may vary by team member.

UPDATED PLAYING RULES CHANGES RELATED TO UNIFORM PATCHES JUNE 30, 2021

In an effort to create more consistency on uniforms and to allow for more decipherable patches, PROP approved the following <u>permanent</u> rules change for all sports effective with the 2021-22 seasons:

- Increase the maximum size of conference, institutional, commemorative, memorial and social justice patches from 2½ to 4 square inches in all sports, with the exception of football and swimming and diving.
- In football, patches must not exceed 16 square inches in area.
- In swimming and diving, patches must not exceed 9 square inches in area.
- The number of allowable patches on the uniform remains unchanged.
- Patches are still required to be in the proper location on the uniform per each sport's playing rules.
- In accordance with NCAA Bylaw 12.5.4, manufacturer's logos in all sports remain restricted to a maximum of 21/4 square inches.
