

2024-25 TRAVEL POLICY CHANGES

DIVISION I and NATIONAL COLLEGIATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Increase per diem rate to \$215 for traveling teams and \$315 for high-cost cities.

Men's and Women's Individual Tennis Championship – addition of fall championship with 32 doubles and 32 singles per gender.

Men's Lacrosse – added 1 additional team to increase the championship from 17 to 18 teams.

Men's Volleyball – added 1 additional team to increase the championship from 8 to 9 teams.

Women's Bowling – added 1 additional team to increase the championship from 18 to 19 teams.

DIVISION II

Increase per diem rate to \$135 for traveling teams.

Winter Festival – per diem paid for duration if attending opening ceremonies.

Festival includes men's and women's indoor track, men's and women's swimming, men's wrestling.

Baseball – squad size increase of 1. Max team size was increased from 25 to 26 and NCAA-paid travel party size increased from 29 to 30. Super regionals will now be a three-day format, and final series will be best of three.

Men's Lacrosse – added 4 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 12 to 16 teams.

Men's and Women's Soccer – format change separating the third and quarterfinal rounds into separate weekends.

Men's and Women's Indoor and Outdoor Track – are going to set field sizes, so this will increase the travel party size for those championships. Will vary based on qualifiers.

Women's Field Hockey – added 2 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 6 to 8.

Women's Golf – added 24 teams to increase the championship from 48 to 72 teams.

Women's Lacrosse – added 8 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 16 to 24 teams.

DIVISION III

Increase per diem rate to \$135 for traveling teams.

Baseball – added 2 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 62 to 64.

Men's Football – added 8 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 32 to 40 teams.

Men's Ice Hockey – added 1 additional team to increase the championship bracket from 13 to 14.

Men's Lacrosse – added 2 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 38 to 40.

Men's Volleyball – added 3 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 16 to 19 teams.

Men's Wrestling – addition of 30 additional participants to increase the championship from 180 participants to 210 participants. This will increase the regionals from 6 sites to 7 sites (NCAA regionals is not a reimbursable round).

Softball – added 2 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 62 to 64.

Women's Field Hockey – added 2 additional teams to increase the championship bracket from 26 to 28.

Women's Ice Hockey – added 1 additional team to increase the championship bracket from 11 to 12.

Women's Lacrosse – added 1 additional team to increase the championship bracket from 46 to 47.

All Divisions

Should an institution elect to travel with more travelers than allowed by NCAA policy, the institution must pay for additional passengers above the NCAA-paid travel party size. For commercial flights, that cost will be the actual cost charged by the airline. For charter flights, the institution will be charged \$500, one way, per additional passenger.
