INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Approve prior meeting report.** The committee approved the May 27, 2026, videoconference report.
2. **Review of bid specs.** The committee reviewed the bid specs for the 2027 and 2028 championships. It is anticipated that bid specs will be released in mid-June after the Division I Cabinet Subcommittee approves the date formula and format recommendation.
3. **NCAA Division I Bylaw 17 Decentralization Feedback – Phase I.** The NCAA Women's Acrobatics and Tumbling Committee discussed the decentralization of Division I Bylaw 17 (Playing and Practice Seasons). The committee provided feedback to the NCAA Division I Cabinet on the first practice date, first competition date, end of the playing season, maximum competition dates, summer athletics activities and health and safety for acrobatics and tumbling.
4. **Selection criteria.** The committee continued to discuss selection criteria and directed staff to draft potential criteria for review prior to making recommendations for the 2027 championship.
