**Message on Behalf of Charles McClelland, Chair of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee and Lisa Peterson, Chair of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee:**

As a result of the 2023-24 playing rules change that allows live and preloaded video on the bench during the regular season, the Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Committees have voted to utilize live and preloaded video on the bench throughout all rounds of the 2024 NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Championships.

The video feed used for this program will be provided by **DVSPORT, Inc.**, a long-time partner of the NCAA.

Each team/bench will be provided **two devices** (iPads/Tablets) per game.

Additional details surrounding this program, including procedures to handle failure of devices, will be provided within the respective 2024 NCAA Tournament Participating Team Manuals.

In addition to technology on the bench, the committee approved the following items for the 2024 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship:

- To increase the number of court-access wristbands provided to the regional and national championship-winning teams for their postgame celebrations to 50. Previously, the number was 30.
- To allow those with a team credential to attend a team's practice without being placed on the 45-member pass gate list. Previously, those individuals needed to be on the list in order to attend.

- During team warm-ups, including the lineup for the national anthem, it is permissible for players not wearing a shooting shirt or other apparel covering devices, such as a Catapult, to still wear those devices, since they are being worn for health and safety reasons. In addition, such devices can bear only the manufacturer's name/logo and can have no other corporate marks on them.
- On the regional final game day, teams will have 60-minute shootaround opportunities. However, if the first game of the day starts at 2 p.m. or earlier (local time), that time may be shortened to 30-minutes to accommodate for the early game start time.

In addition to technology on the bench, the committee approved the following items for the 2024 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship:

- To increase the number of court-access wristbands provided to the regional and national championship-winning teams for their postgame celebrations to 50. Previously, the number was 30.
- To increase the number of postgame credentials for both teams following the regional final and national championship games to 10 and will be provided at halftime. Previously, the number was 5 and were provided postgame only to the winning team.
