

2022-23 Men's Basketball Rules Change

The following rules change was approved by the NCAA Men's Basketball Rules Committee and the Playing Rules Oversight Panel. This change will be incorporated into the rules book for the 2022-23 season.

Rule(s)	Rules Proposal and Rationale
4-10.2	To remove the required initial warning and assess a Class B technical foul when a player commits a flop.
(Flopping)	
	Rationale: Flopping continues to be a major concern in our game, and the rules committee felt that the current
	penalty of an initial warning for flopping has not deterred players from continuing to flop. An immediate penalty
	for flopping is needed to curb this behavior. The rules committee will also provide additional guidance to players,
	coaches and officials to better define flopping. This rules change has been reviewed and supported by the Division
	I Men's Basketball Competition Committee as well as the Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee.
