



2025-26 Men's Basketball Rules - Survey Results

Methods

- This was a survey of head coaches, athletics directors, conference commissioners, senior woman administrators, conference MBB administrators, conference coordinators of officials and game officials. The purpose was to assess the impact of rules changes, if rules were correctly adjudicated and possible rules changes.
- The survey was designed to take no more than 10 minutes and was administered online through the Qualtrics survey software.
- The survey was open from March 30 to April 20, 2026.
- The survey was distributed via email to 4,086 coaches, officials, conference MBB administrators and conference coordinators of officials. The link to the survey was made available through an online survey dashboard designed for athletics directors, senior woman administrators and conference commissioners to provide rules feedback during the 2025-26 academic year. A notice about the use of the survey dashboard was emailed to all athletics directors, senior woman administrators and conference commissioners prior to the survey launch. A follow-up email was sent to those who received the survey via email and a notice about survey dashboard availability appeared in the *NCAA Weekly* each Monday while the survey was open. Of the 5,199 possible participants, there were 854 completed surveys (16 percent response rate).

Note: Items shaded in blue represent a response percentage at or above 60%.

Key Findings

2025-26 Current Rules Assessment

- Overall, 70% of head coaches, 73% of athletics directors and 92% of game officials indicated that *Rule 4-6 Continuous Motion (i.e. A player with the ball who is fouled after the dribble has ended and judged to be attempting a shot, may complete one step in order to complete the shooting motion)* had a positive impact on the game).
- Over 85% of head coaches and game officials reported that *Rule 11 (i.e. Establish a coach's challenge on called out of bounds plays, called basket interference/goaltending plays and restricted area plays)* had a positive impact on the game.

2025-26 Officiating Enforcement

Please indicate how frequently the following rules were correctly adjudicated in the men's college basketball games you attended, officiated or coached:

- The majority of athletics directors (62%) and conference commissioners (69%) responded that the *emphasis on reducing rough post play* rule was sometimes correctly adjudicated.
- About 60% of head coaches and three-quarters of coordinator of officials indicate the *enforcement of flopping rules on jump shooters faking being fouled* rule is almost never correctly adjudicated.

Future Rules Considerations

- Over three-quarters of head coaches and athletics directors and 65% of game officials oppose the possible rule change: *a defender who takes away a jump shooter's landing space shall be charged with a flagrant foul.*
- The majority of Division I (64%) and Division II (61%) head coaches and about two-thirds of game officials oppose the possible rules change to *modify the Coach's Challenge rule to include review if an off-ball foul occurred prior to the shooter starting the shooting motion.*
