Team control continues until there is a try for goal, the opponets secure control of the ball, or the ball becomes dead. Regarding team-control fouls, which option would you prefer (choose one):

A. Change the definition of team-control foul to only include when a teammate of a player **who is holding or dribbling the ball** commits a personal foul. Fouls committed when the ball is loose due to a fumble, interrupted dribble, defensive deflection, or when a pass between teammates is in flight would merit free throws when the bonus is in effect.

Rationale: To increase consistency in the adjuducation of fouls when team control may be in question.

Team-Control Foul CONTINUED

B. Change the definition of team-control foul to only include when a teammate of a player **who is holding or dribbling the ball or when a pass between teammates is in flight**, commits a personal foul. Fouls committed when the ball is loose due to a fumble, interrupted dribble or defensive deflection would merit free throws when the bonus is in effect.

Rationale: To increase consistency in the adjudication of fouls when team control may be in question.
