



REPORT OF THE
NCAA WOMEN'S BOWLING OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
NOVEMBER 5, 2025, VIDEOCONFERENCE

ACTION ITEMS.

1. Legislative items.

- None.

2. Nonlegislative items.

- **Championship squad size limit.**

- (1) Recommendation. The Women's Bowling Oversight Committee requests the Division I Cabinet increase the designated championship squad size from 10 to 11 to align with the roster limit in Division I Bylaw 17.2 (roster limit). The official travel party and bench limit size will remain at 13.
- (2) Effective date. Immediate.
- (3) Rationale. The increase from 10 to 11 aligns with the *House settlement* roster limit in Bylaw 17.2 (roster limit).
- (4) Estimated budget impact. Varies by institution.
- (5) Student-athlete impact. Potential additional participation opportunities during the National Collegiate Women's Bowling Championship.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Referral from cabinet: Use of commercial logos.** The committee discussed and supported the use of commercial logos on student-athlete uniforms and personal equipment (i.e. bowling balls) and provided feedback on locations. The committee also noted that logos on equipment, such as lanes would be cost prohibitive and most likely impractical, given they are renting facilities for competition. Finally, the committee discussed the importance of aligning the use of commercial logos with the United States Bowling Congress, if possible, given the overlap in competitions.
2. **Playing rules change proposal process/timeline.** The committee reviewed the playing rules change proposal timeline. Concepts to consider for future rules changes must be submitted by February through the NCAA Playing Rules Proposal Form.
3. **Tournament match results – score reporting system.** The committee discussed the recently implemented score reporting system updates, noting committee chairs and staff are tracking submissions. Initial feedback is that these improvements have been well received by the membership.

4. **BowlTV coverage of regionals.** The committee discussed BowlTV's coverage of regional competition and noted the importance of broadcast teams including individuals who have participated or coached in the sport at the collegiate level. Committee members will provide names of individuals to BowlTV for consideration.
5. **Preseason coach videoconference feedback.** The committee discussed the preseason coach videoconference that occurred on October 1 as informational. Committee members will continue discussing how content and coach attendance can be improved.
