Important Dates and Deadlines

- Thursday, May 20
 - 11:59 p.m.: deadline for FQ meet results submission.
- Friday, May 21 Selections
 - 9 a.m.: final descending order list posted.
 - 1 p.m.: declarations/scratches due.
 - 3 p.m.: late declaration/scratch deadline \$400 fine per gender.
 - 8 p.m.: final list of meet participants posted to NCAA.com.

Total Travel Party Allowances

Student-Athletes	Non-Athletes
1-10	2
11-15	3
16+	4

- Additional non-athlete spaces available for medical and/or admin.
- Teams cannot bring additional personnel and pay for additional testing.
- Up to two (2) relay alternates per qualified relay.
- Team Health Officer (THO) designation.





COVID-19 Testing Protocols

Prearrival test:

- Negative PRC within 48 hours of arrival on site.
- Negative antigen within 24 hours of arrival on site.

Testing on site:

- Low/medium transmission rate;
- Testing at least every 48 hours;
- Exception for fully vaccinated individuals.





COVID-19 Testing Protocols

Testing on site:

- Initial testing time will be sent Sunday evening.
- Everyone in travel party must report to testing.
- Every 48 hours while on site.
- Subsequent testing times will be communicated to schools.
- Vaccinated individuals are exempt from testing but must still come to the initial testing time for verification.
- 90-day window.

COVID-19 Protocols

- 2021 NCAA Championship Participant Code of Conduct
 - Official travel party will be Tier 1.
 - Physical distancing and masking.
- Designated seating for Tier 1 individuals designated in stadium.
- Designated stadium entrance for Tier 1 personnel.
- Must show credential and "all clear" email to enter stadium.





Practice

• Tuesday and Wednesday: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- Long throws:
 - 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. Hammer
 - 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. Javelin
 - 12 p.m. to 1 p.m. Discus
 - 1 p.m. to 2 p.m. Hammer
 - 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. Javelin
 - 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. Discus

*must be cleared from testing before practicing.

Implement Check-In

- Wednesday, May 26: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Thursday, Friday, Saturday: during competition hours.
- House implements provided by Gill Athletics.
- Permitted to use own implements if they pass inspection.
- For early event, check in implements the day before.





Clerking

- Clerking will take place behind back stretch bleachers.
- Warm-ups will be left at clerking in designated areas.
- Student-athletes will be escorted to event starts from clerking.
- Spikes:
 - 7mm
 - 9mm high jump, javelin
 - Pyramid of compression
 - No "Christmas tree" or "needle" spikes





Schedule Notes

- 10,000 meters Thursday evening 8:30 p.m. and 9:15 p.m.
- Steeplechase single race final Friday afternoon.
- Field event flights will remain until finals are called.





Coaches Boxes

- Coaches' boxes will be designated on site.
- Stickers will be distributed at packet pick-up.
- One coach per institution, per box.

- Relay alternates:
 - Up to two (2) per qualified relay.
 - Must be included on submitted travel party for with selections information.
 - Additional allowance in tested travel party.

*All potential relay alternates should be entered into Direct Athletics. There is no penalty for entering and not traveling.
