NOTE: This diagram illustrates the possible/most commonly used locations for field logo markings but does not imply that eight flanking logos are allowed. See Rule 1-2-1-g and FCAG #1, and conference policy for specifications and limitations of logos.

NCAA Football Rules - The Field (Rule 1-2-1-g)

All contrasting and decorative markings and advertisements are permissible within the sidelines and between the goal lines and are governed by the home team conference (See FCAG #1), under the following conditions:

- If decorative markings or advertising touch or cover a yard line, the entire 4-inch line must be clearly visible at field level with a shadow line or other covering technique.
- Goal lines and sidelines must be clearly visible, and no portion of any such line may be touched or covered by decorative markings or advertising.
- Decorative markings or advertising may not touch or enclose the hash marks or numbers.
