

## **EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2023**

## Course Access During Regular Season – Finals Site

The NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Golf Committees have adopted the following policy for the regular season specific to the finals site that will conduct the respective back-to-back national championships:

Beginning August 1, 2023, student-athletes and coaches are prohibited from walking, playing, or practicing at the championship finals course (i.e., practice facilities and any additional golf course at the venue) other than those student-athletes and coaches with preexisting course memberships or who are competing in sanctioned events of the state's amateur or professional golf associations, the USGA, LPGA and PGA. Violations of this policy may result in sanctions listed under NCAA misconduct provisions or disqualification for a team or an individual(s), with no substitution permitted. Limited exceptions may be approved for members of the Division I Men's and Women's Golf Committees and host planning committee to be on site during times when championship planning is occurring.
