



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S AND WOMEN'S GOLF COMMITTEES
AUGUST 10, 2022, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Welcome new members.** The committees welcomed and introduced new committee members for the 2022-23 academic year.
2. **Schedule submission policy.** The committees reviewed the schedule submission policy, which will change for the 2023-24 academic year to require teams to submit competition schedules by August 31. The current schedule submission policy requires teams to submit competition schedules by October 1 each season.

The committees recognize that a loophole still exists, should a team schedule below the maximum number of competition dates when submitting their schedule by the established deadline. The committees will continue to evaluate potential policies that may help close this loophole in the future. Currently, all schedule changes after the established schedule submission deadline are subject to committee approval.

3. **2023 championships planning.** The committees discussed plans for the 2023 championships, which will be hosted by Arizona State University and The Thunderbirds at Grayhawk Golf Club for the third consecutive year.
4. **2024 championships update.** The committees received an update from Dan Surette, Chief Sales Officer from Omni Hotels and Resorts, regarding the progress of the golf course renovations at Omni La Costa in Carlsbad, CA, host site for the 2024-26 championships. Mr. Surette informed the committee that permitting for the project remains on schedule, with improvements scheduled to begin prior to the end of the year. Committee members noted their concerns with the renovation schedule and discussed tentative plans to pursue and secure an alternate facility for the championships, should renovations be further delayed.
5. **Summer 2023 annual committee meeting dates.** The committees tentatively set their 2023 annual meeting dates, with the men's committee to meet June 26-28, the women's committee to meet June 27-29, and a joint meeting session with both committees on June 28.
6. **Other business.** The committees discussed timing of the Folds of Honor presentations at the national championships and expressed their continued desire to include as many teams as possible. Committee members and staff noted challenges with all possible options regarding timing of the presentations due to the overlap with student-athlete warm-ups prior to the final round of stroke play competition.
