



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S AND WOMEN'S GOLF COMMITTEES
DECEMBER 6, 2022, COMMITTEE MEETING**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Coaches' convention preparation.** The committees discussed their divisional respective breakout sessions for the Golf Coaches Association of America and Women's Golf Coaches Association meetings, which were scheduled for later in the same day, on Tuesday, December 6. Committee members and staff discussed the primary topics for their discussions which include several legislative items from the Division I Transformation Committee that will be voted upon at the 2023 NCAA Convention in January. The committees also discussed the Rules of Golf and strategized regarding the women's golf committee's ongoing efforts to obtain approval for their request to have 30 teams qualify for their championship finals.
2. **Model Local Rule G-12.** The committees discussed Model Local Rule G-12, which becomes an optional local rule for tournament organizers to adopt within the Rules of Golf on January 1, 2023. The United States Golf Association will adopt Model Local Rule G-12 for their elite level amateur championships beginning in 2023. Committee members were not unanimous in their stance on option of this model local rule beginning with the 2023 Division I NCAA Men's and Women's Golf Championships. Committee members noted that they will solicit feedback from members of their respective coaches' associations before making a final decision on implementation of this model local rule during the current academic year.
3. **Golf scoring and ranking services request for proposal.** The committee received an update from staff regarding the ongoing golf scoring and ranking services request for proposal. Responses are due back by Friday, December 16. Staff noted that they expect to receive multiple proposals by the deadline.
4. **2024 championships update.** The committees received an update regarding the progress of the golf course renovations at Omni La Costa in Carlsbad, CA, host site for the 2024-26 championships. Staff informed the committee that permitting for the golf course project should conclude within the week, with course renovations scheduled to begin later in December. Committee members were also informed that permitting for the practice facility renovations were separated from the permitting for the golf course renovations; that permitting process will resume in early 2023. Committee members noted their concerns with the renovation schedule and discussed tentative plans to pursue and secure an alternate facility for the championships, should renovations be further delayed.
