NCAA DIVISION II WOMEN'S GOLF COMMITTEE  
APRIL 10, 2026, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

**ACTION ITEMS.**

**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **Welcome and review of agenda.** Division II Women's Golf Committee Chair Dominic Guarnieri welcomed the group and previewed the key agenda items.
2. **Additional individual qualifier bid allocation.** The Division II Women's Golf Committee supports awarding the additional individual qualifier to the region of the previous individual champion. This approach promotes broader regional representation by increasing the likelihood that a different region earns the additional individual berth, rather than allowing regions to receive both an extra team and an extra individual. It also aligns with the existing framework used for team qualification, in which the previous year's team champion and runner-up regions are awarded additional team berths, ensuring consistency in how success is recognized across both team and individual competition.

In reaching this position, the committee reviewed a 10-year history of team and individual champions by region. Over that period, the West produced three team champions and four individual champions, the East produced four team champions and three individual champions, and the South produced three team champions and three individual champions. The Central region did not produce a team or individual champion during that span. This distribution further supports a model that balances recognition of competitive success with broader regional access, awarding the previous year's individual champion's region, which may increase student-athlete post-season opportunities.

- 3. 2025-26 Tiebreaking procedures.** The committee provided additional clarification for sudden-victory playoffs. If a team does not have a fifth player available due to a medical or extenuating circumstance, the committee may allow the team to compete with four players and count four scores relative to par. Teams with five players may still compete with all five players; however, only the four lowest scores relative to par will count.
