MAY 26, 2026, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

**ACTION ITEMS.**

**2. Nonlegislative items.**

- **2028 final site recommendation.**

- a. Recommendation. Approve the following final site for the 2028 Division II Women's Golf Championships.

- b. Effective date. Immediate.

- c. Rationale. The Division II Women's Golf Committee has been accepting final site bids for 2028 since October 2025. The committee was able to provide a recommendation for the 2028 final site. The committee is confident in the quality of the proposed site, citing a strong history of hosting PGA events and the prestige of the Mystic Rock course at Nemacolin. The 2028 bid from Nemacolin in Farmington, Pennsylvania, includes average greens fees ranging from \$300 to \$350 per round. However, the venue is offering a reduced rate of \$75 per round. In addition, the facility provides ample space for teams to utilize practice facilities onsite. The committee noted the course would provide student-athletes with a championship-caliber experience on a course that has not hosted the championships before.

- d. Estimated budget impact. The projected budget expenditures are as follows:

| Final Site | Projected Budget Expenditures |

(For reference, budget expenditures for the final site have usually been between \$75,000 and \$90,000 depending on the location.)

- e. Student-athlete impact. The proposed 2028 final site at Nemacolin would provide competition on a championship-caliber course, offering student-athletes a new venue and the opportunity to compete at a site that has not previously hosted the championships.
