7. 2019-20 Selection Process. Both fall and spring schedules will be considered. A team or individual must compete in a minimum of four contests (minimum of 18 holes) after Jan. 1 of each year. The institutions that earned their conferences' automatic qualifier in the fall are not required to play in four contests after the first of the year, but the men's golf committee recommends that a spring schedule is conducted. For junior varsity contests, the respective school must inform the host institution that its junior varsity program will participate and that its team score should not appear on the 15. Future Dates and Sites. tournament results form; however, individual scores may be reported. Waivers will be accepted by the men's golf committee for teams or individuals that have not met eligibility requirements due to weather or other extenuating circumstances. Waivers must be submitted in writing to the NCAA championship manager before the selection date.

To be considered during the selection process either as an automatic berth (Pool A) or an at-large berth (Pool B and Pool C), an institution must play at least 25 percent of its competition against Division III in-region opponents, unless a waiver has been approved by the Division III Championships Committee.

- 8. Regional Rankings. Regional rankings will be published on NCAA.com April 9, 16, and 23. A fourth regional ranking will be published after the selection announcement on May 4.
- 9. Championships Format. The team and individual champions will be determined after 72 holes of play. After 36 holes of competition, the field will be cut to the top 18 teams and top six individuals not on one of those teams. Ties for the cut will be broken by a sudden-death playoff or, if necessary, by the non sudden-death tiebreaking procedures set forth in the pre-championships manual.
- 10. Annual Meetings. The 2020 NCAA Division III Men's Golf Committee annual meeting will take place June 23-24 in Indianapolis. Submit agenda items in writing to the NCAA championships manager, John Kuzio by June 5, 2020. Men's golf committee reports can be found online on the DIII Men's Golf landing page and championships committee meeting reports can be found on the DIII Championships Committee landing page.

- 11. Pre-Championship Manual. The 2019-20 NCAA Division III Men's Golf Pre-Championships Manual will be posted in January on the men's golf sport landing page.
- 12. Rules. The 2019-20 Hard Card is posted on the Division III Men's Golf landing page at NCAA.org.

## 14. 2020 Championship Dates and Site.

Selection Announcement: Monday, May 4, 2020. National Championships: May 12-15, 2020. PGA National in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida. Emory University and Palm Beach County Sports Commission, hosts. Joint championship with DIII Women's Golf.

2021 Selection Announcement: Monday, May 3, 2021. National Championships: May 11-14, 2021. Oglebay Resort in Wheeling, West Virginia. Bethany College (West Virginia) and Presidents' Athletic Conference, hosts.

2022 Selection Announcement: Monday, May 2, 2022. National Championships: May 10-13, 2022. Mission Inn Resort & Club in Howey-in-the-Hills, Florida. Oglethorpe University and Greater Orlando Sports Commission, hosts.

Date Formula Change. The men's and women's committee surveyed the membership and made a proposal to the championships committee to alternate years. Beginning with the 2023 championships, the men's date formula will be the 3rd Tuesday in May in odd-numbered years and the 2nd Tuesday in May in even-numbered years.

2023 Selection Announcement: Monday, May 8, 2023. National Championships: May 16-19, 2023.

2024 Selection Announcement: Monday, May 6, 2024. National Championships: May 14-17, 2024.

2025 Selection Announcement: Monday, May 12, 2025. National Championships: May 20-23, 2025.

2026 Selection Announcement: Monday, May 4, 2026. National Championships: May 12-15, 2026.

16. 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026 Bid Process. The bid portal is open and bids are being accepted until Feb. 3, 2020. Hosts/sites will be announced Oct. 23. Bid specifications are posted on ncaa.org/bids.
