

REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION III WOMEN'S GOLF COMMITTEE OCTOBER 29, 2025, VIDEOCONFERENCE

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. NCAA banquet and WGCA discussion. The women's golf committee met with representatives of the WGCA to discuss the possibility of a joint banquet for the 2026 championship.
- 2. 2026 site visit recap. The NCAA championship liaison and women's golf committee chair provided updates on their site visit in September. The committee expressed excitement for the championship ahead.
- **3. Regionals proposal updat**e. The committee was updated on the status of the regionals proposal, which was submitted to the Division III Championships Committee for review in September and returned for additional information. The committee was provided the status of those updates and next steps.
- **4. Clippd update.** The committee agreed to remind teams that tournaments with yardages that do not meet yardage minimums will not count toward their overall records and Clippd rankings.
- **5. Automatic qualifiers.** The committee reviewed the 26 conferences that requested automatic qualifiers for the 2025-26 championships. The newest conference to request an automatic qualifier is the Conference of New England. The committee agreed to remind teams to review the 2025-26 Sport Sponsorship and pool document found on the Division III women's golf ncaa.org page.
- **6. Fall automatic qualifiers.** The committee reviewed the current fall automatic qualifiers and extended congratulations to those teams. Championship information will be shared with those teams once it is finalized.
- 7. Other business. Staff noted that the Request for Accommodations for Student-Athletes has now been posted on the Division III Women's Golf on NCAA.org and reminded committee members that this process takes up to two weeks.
